## **ISSF Changwon World Cup 2019**

### **Trap Mixed Team Format for the 17<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

Due to time limitation in the Tokyo Olympic 2020 program.  
We have to amend the Trap Mixed Team rule in order to make the Format fit in the time schedule established by the Organizing Committee of the Games.

#### **Qualification Rounds: First Part**

Each team will shoot 100 targets. 50 targets (2 rounds) for each team members.

Men and Women of the same team will shoot together side by side.  
On the allocated Ranges.

The total score of each team will be combined to determine the top 6 teams.

In case of Team Tie score for place 6, there will be a shoot-off to decide the position, and both team members shoot.

## **Qualification Round: Second Part**

The Top 6 Teams will move to the Second Part of the Qualification. Each team will shoot 50 targets. 25 targets for each team member. Same procedure like the First Part.

The total score will be combined to determine the Top 4 Teams which will move to the Final Stage: The Medal Match Stage.

The best 2 teams will move to Gold Medal Match and the other 2 teams (3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Places) will go to Bronze Medal Match.

And the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Place team, after the combined score will be determined.

In case of Tie score, the Shoot off will determine the Top 4 teams and also for Ranking (1 to 4).

## **Medal Matches Stage:**

Bronze Medal Match will start first at 17:00 hrs. on B Range.

50 Targets to be shot per team.

Men and Women of the same team shoot together side by side.

In case of Tie score, the higher BIB number (4) will be determined.

Gold Medal Match will start after the conclusion of the Bronze Medal Match.

Men and Women of the same team will shoot 50 targets together on Range B. Same condition as the Bronze Medal Match.

But in case of Tie score of the Gold Medal Match, the Shoot off rule will apply.

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The Bronze Medal Match will be shot first, followed by the Gold Medal match.

## **Trap**

25 targets each athlete from stations 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 (2 right, 1 center & 2 left target from each station).

Only one (1) shot is permitted at each target (Rule 9.15.5.2 c).

The final ranking will be decided by the combined results of the 2 members of the team of each nation (1 man & 1 woman)  
25X2=50.

Note: Preparation time limit = 12 seconds.

In case of a tie, this will be broken by shoot-off

### Shoot off:

Both members of each tied team must participate in the shoot-off.

Each team coach must designate which team member (male or female) will shoot the first target.

Only one (1) shot is permitted at each target. (Rule 9.15.5.2 c).

The athletes designated to shoot first must line up behind station 1 in bib number order and shoot at a regular target, according to Rule 9.15.5.2.

If the tie is not broken, the same procedure will continue on station 2 with the second member of each team shooting.

This procedure will continue with the team members shooting in alternate order (Team member.

Shooting order will be 1-2-2- 1 -1 - 2, - 2, etc.) on successive stations until the tie is broken.

Note: Preparation time limit = 12 seconds
